SUMMARY

From 2015 onwards, George Soros has been negotiating with the highest decision-makers in the European Union. He had three main objectives. The first was to make the agendas of the US liberal-progressive elite part of the European mainstream policy. The second was to force reluctant Member States to implement these agendas through the means of the European Union. The third was to keep the Brussels institutional system under occupation, to divert its resources: to continue network building with internal EU funding, protected by Union rules, excluding national control.

The transatlantic network of interests imposed its will on the EU political elite: they corrupted hundreds of representatives, created the largest informal body of representatives in the EP, and took over the main decision-making, doctrine-making and executive bodies, filling them with their loyal people. The changeover has taken place. Brussels is now the bridgehead of this globalist-progressive elite.

Over the last decade and a half, Hungary has taken steps to raise awareness among Hungarian citizens of foreign political pressure organisations and their activities, as well as to stop their practices that violate sovereignty. As a result, Hungary has been under constant pressure for ten years and domestic and foreign policy, the national economy and society as a whole is a target of attempts to influence.

Hungarian members of the Soros network play a central role in the occupation of Brussels and in gaining control over the distribution of European civil society funds. This new system is still evolving, its funding system is being restructured to ensure the lack of transparency, and the European funds available are constantly increasing. The sovereignty of the Member States, particularly Hungary, is under threat, as the Soros network and Brussels seek to set a deterrent example to others.
